## **Bald Cypress**

Lindsay Skyward	25'30'	sp.5-10; soft green foliage changing to copper In fall;upright form;resistant to ice storm stress; likes wet feet
Falling Waters Weeping	20'	arching form good for specimen planting; likes wet feet

## **Bradford Pear (Pyrus)**

Cleveland Select	25-30'	cone shaped; white bloom Red/yellow/orange fall color

## **Box Elder (Acer)**

Sensation	60'	sp. 35'; rounded habit; more controlled and better branching habits than traditional species; brilliant red fall color; seedless

## **Catalpa**

Purple Catalpa	30'	sp. 30'; new growth is purple-black in color; large leaves with a purple hue as summer progresses; abundant, showy white flowers

## **Crabapple (Malus)**

April Showers	8-10'	sp. 4-6'; weeping habit; light pink to white bloom Bright red small crabapple in fall; attracts birds
Marilee	25'	sp. 10'; upright form;pink-red buds open to semi double white blooms; little or no fruit
Sargent Tina	5'-6'	10-12' spread; red buds open to white bloom; red 1/4" fruit; very disease resistant; dwarf tree; excellent patio container tree
Spring Snow	20-25'	Fruitless; upright oval shape;white bloom;heat tolerant
Thunderchild	15-20'	15-20' sp; dark purple leaves; pink bloom; dark purple fruit 3/8"; orange yellow fall color

## **Elm (Ulmus)**

Frontier	25'	sp.15'; burgundy fall color; compact oval; Dutch Elm Disease resistant
New Horizon	50'	sp.25'; coarse textured dark green leaves similar to Amer. Elm; good shade tree-densely leafed, compact, upright; rusty red in fall

Princeton	60'-80'	sp. 40-50'; upright vase shape like Amer. Elm; Good resistance to Dutch Elm dis; yellow fall; Tolerant
<b>Goldenraintree (Koelrueteria paniculata)</b>		
(1)species	30-40'	20-25' sp; dense smaller tree with rounded form; blooming showy, fragrant, yellow flower panicles turn to reddish, pink, leathery fruit capsules
<b>Honeylocust (Gleditsia)</b>		
Shademaster	50-60'	sp.30-35;wide spreading symmetrical form; yellow fall color; thornless and seedless
Street Keeper	45'	sp.20';narrow upright pyramidal; thornless
<b>Juniper</b>		
Hetzi Columnar	15-18'	sp. 5-8'; narrow columnar vigorous grower
Skyrocket	15-20'	sp.3-6';narrow columnar form silver blue foliage
Wichita Blue	18'	sp. 6-8';narrow pyramidal form; blue foliage
<b>Kentucky Coffeetree (Gymnocladus)</b>		
species	40-50'	20'-25' sp; open branching habit; good for letting sun through in winter, thick foliage in summer for shade; med fast grower
Espresso	50'	sp 35'; seedless; yellow fall color; oval to case shape with upright arching branches; elm-like form
<b>Lilac, treeform</b>		
Ivory Silk	15-20'	sp.10-15'; compact round form;white bloom mid-summer;drought resistant
<b>Linden(Tilia)</b>		
Greenspire	40-50'	15'-25' sp; dense narrow, oval form; med fast grower; yellow fall color; extremely straight trunk and central leader; cinnamon colored bark
<b>London Planetree (Platanus)</b>		
Bloodgood	50-80'	30-40'; wide spreading, open form; exfoliating white bark
Exclamation!	55'	sp.35'; upright pyramidal shape; white bark
<b>Maple(Acer)</b>		
Autumn Blaze	40-50'	sp.20-25';upright form;silver/red cross gorws in higher ph soils;orange/red fall color;

Celebration	35-45"	sp. 30-40'; upright, compact; tolerates high ph; Red to gold fall color; SEEDLESS!
Flame	15-20'	white fragrant flowers; red fall color; slow grower very cold hardy; tolerates high ph soil & shade
Firefall	40-60'	sp. 30-40'; bright orange to scarlet fall color; Upright oval w/good branching; SEEDLESS!
(1) Sensation	60'	sp. 35'; round habit; red fall color; SEEDLESS!
<b>Oak (Quercus)</b>		
Burr	40-50'	native hardy; very slow growing; yellow/brown in fall
Shumard	50-60'	upright form; tolerates high pH; red/orange in fall
Sawtooth	35-45'	sp. 30-35'; broad pyramidal; clean foliated lawn tolerant of heat and high ph
<b>Ornamental cherry (Prunus)</b>		
Merlot (Birdcherry)	25-30'	15-20' sp; very uniform, upright growth; retains deep burgundy color
Snow Fountain weeping	12-15'	sp. 12-15'; white bloom; orange fall color; heat & drought tolerant;
<b>Red bud (Cercis)</b>		
Common	20-25'	early purple/pink blooms; shiny green foliage
<b>Serviceberry (Amelanchier)</b>		
Autumn Brilliance	20"	sp. 15'; fast growing good red fall color; edible fruit
Rainbow Pillar	20'	sp. 8-10'; upright form; sm white flower; red/orange/yellow fall color; good hedge/screen
<b>Smoketree (Cotinus)</b>		
Royal Purple	15-20'	round form; purple smoke; purple leaves keep color all summer; good flame fall color
(2) Grace	20'	spread 15-20'; lg. pink smoke; leaves are red When young darkens to blue green; red/orange/yellow in fall
<b>Spruce</b>		
(2) Colorado Mixed	60'	25' sp.
Fastigiata	25'	6' sp; upright branching; blue new growth
Fat Albert	30'	15' sp; broad, pyramidal shape
(4) The Blues Weeping	5-6'	very floppy growing pattern causing it to grow over the ground rather than upright

**Willow(Salix)**

Globe	20'	20' sp. Compact round head; tolerant of poor, drier soil
Hakuro Nishiki	6-8'	new growth pink into variegated dappled pink/white/green; unique accent plant

**Zelkova**

Green Vase	60'	sp. 40-45'; Vase shape; orange-brown to bronzed fall color; fast growing; tolerant of city cond.
(1) Musashino Columnar	45'	sp. 12' very narrow upright vase shape; short Trunk good for street tree use ; fast grower; adaptable to most soils; drought toleran
